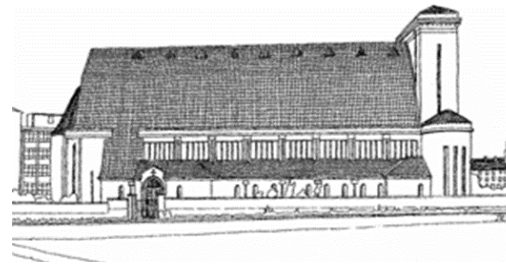


PRAYER FOR ST COLUMBA'S PARISH
