31st March 2024 – Easter Sunday

Introduction to the Mass: Today is the first day of the week, a celebration of new beginnings. Our readings challenge us to think about life differently because of the Easter events. God had entered our lives in a decisive way, showing us the depth of divine love. We can never forget this, and must now live always conscious of God's transforming presence in our lives.

Easter Vigil – Gospel (Mk 16:1-8) This messenger at the tomb announces to the world that Jesus has passed through death to a new, transformed life, but that he is still intimately linked to his disciples and calls them to follow him.

Easter Sunday First Reading (Acts 10:34, 37 -43) Peter baptises the first Gentile, the Roman centurion, Cornelius. God led Peter to a future he never expected, and Peter responded with joyful obedience.

Easter Sunday second Reading (Col 3:1-4) We must think and act differently because of our faith in the resurrection. We must now seek the things that are above and be inspired by the values of the world of faith.

Easter Sunday – Gospel (Jn 20:1-9) We hear of the first discovery of the empty tomb and the realization by the early disciples that Jesus was truly risen from the dead.
