GOSPEL—Mark 13:33-37

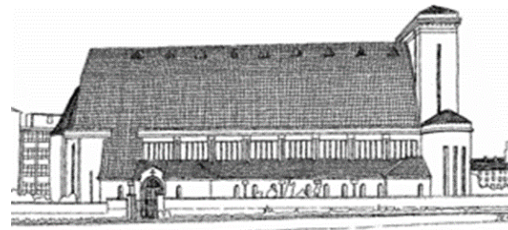
