24th March 2024 – Palm Sunday

First Reading: (Isa 50:4-7) The suffering Servant is untouched by insults and abuse. He relies on the Lord's word for strength in much the same way as Jesus will do during his passion.

Second Reading: (Phil 2:6-11) Paul uses this hymn to speak of Christ and to offer the same promise to the community. Just as Jesus' humiliation and death led to God's glorification and exaltation of Christ, so will it be for us.

The Passion: (Mk 14:1- 15:47) The Passion according to Mark is the earliest account we have of the suffering and death of Jesus. It offers contracts between faith and denial in its portrayal of Jesus and the disciples, and invites us to examine our faith in times of trial.
