Of worship to the Servant King

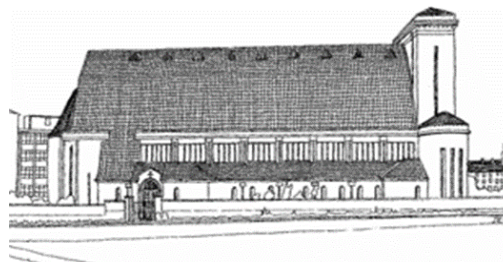
*There in the garden of tears

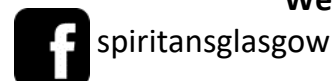
