CKC Working Certificate Test Rules and Regulations - January 2023 Section 14.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities. The WC Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

#### RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION OF LANDOWNERS AND THE WRHRC

By entering this event, each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the event and agrees to release, save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of the property upon which the event is held, together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person, dog, or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participant's use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participant and all of his heirs, executors and assigns.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Entries made online through Dogshow.ca only. Owners are responsible for any errors on the online entry forms. The WRHRC does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information or errors on any entry form.
- Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date of Sunday, July 21, 2024 at 6:00 PM MT. In the
  event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or barred from competition by action of the
  WC Test Committee or the Canadian Kennel Club, or because it has been entered incorrectly, or if it is
  impossible to open or complete the test, no refund of entry will be made.
- 3. Running order will be available shortly afterwards and posted/emailed to all participants before the
- 4. Bitches in season shall <u>not</u> be eligible for entry in any entry and shall <u>not</u> be allowed on the test grounds.
- 5. Ducks and / or pheasants will be used on land and ducks will be used for all water tests.
- 6. **Scratches** will be fully refunded for a bitch in season. All other scratches will forfeit the full entry.
- 7. Entry and TCN fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of estrus, injury, illness or death shall be refunded in full. An appropriate veterinary certificate must be given to the Test Secretary BEFORE the start of the test to qualify for a refund. All other refunds must be requested in writing within 14 days of the event, explaining the reason for the scratch. Scratches will be refunded at the discretion of the WC Test Committee, all but a fee of \$15.00.
- 8. All tests will be run at the same location and all land retrieves for all tests will be run before water tests.
- All Throwers, Judges and Competitors should wear dark or camouflage clothing. Handlers shall not wear white or light clothing at any time, but handlers may wear handling jackets for the blind in the WCX.
- 10. Any dog not appearing within 15 minutes of being called to the line by the Marshall may be disqualified.
- 11. Electric collars (either dummy or live), prong or pinch type collars shall not be worn by any dog on the grounds, at any time during the event.
- 12. As per section 10.1.6 No training will be allowed on the test grounds within 24 hours of the start of the test. A bumper thrown by the handler for the purpose of a warm-up shall not be considered training
- 13. Alcoholic beverages are NOT ALLOWED / CONSUMED on the Test Grounds during the tests!
- 14. The WRHRC will not be responsible for any loss or damage to any dog or to any equipment, whether the result of an accident or otherwise. Furthermore, the WRHRC will assume no liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to event participants, bystanders, club members, workers or other individuals using the property for any purpose.

**Temporary Competition Number (TCN):** Owners of unregistered CKC recognized breeds entering events are required to obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). A TCN allows dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). Dogs not registered in Canada must obtain a TCN before submitting an entry for a working certificate test. A TCN fee of \$10.00 + GST must be included with your entry fees. CKC Registration or ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the working certificate test or all awards will be canceled.
