TCN FEES: Temporary Competition Number (TCN), replacing Listing: TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs", and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). The current TCN fee is \$10.00 per trial (i.e. per dog, per day).

CKC Non-member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian nonmember of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee (\$64.00 + taxes).
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "This only applies to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member.

- ENTRIES CLOSE 6 pm Sunday June 27, 2021 or when the limit has been reached. (NO EXCEPTIONS). If the limit hasn't been reached Angela Borthwick or Lisa Williams will accept entries at the ACHRA trial by 3pm.
- 5. Same day entries will <u>not</u> be accepted.
- 6. Draw will take place at 7 p.m., June 29, 2021.
- 7. A separate entry form for EACH dog in EACH stake is required (official CKC entry form). Available editable online entries with ability to save on your computer may be found on the CKC website under CKC Events/Forms (You may also use entry form provided here). Non-CKC members please read note below.
- 8. All entries must be accompanied by the entry fee (and TCN fee of \$10.50 if applicable). The TCN fee of \$10.50 (GST included) per dog per event is payable unless the dog entered has a CKC individual registration number or ERN number.
- 9. NO PHONE/FAX ENTRIES or E-TRANSFER PAYMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Due to COVID 19, printed catalogues will NOT be provided. The catalogue will be emailed to the participants, along with a running order, in advance of the test.

Unfortunately, due to COVID 19, we will not be having a tailgate on Saturday evening.


General Information

- 1. Copies of the Hunt Test Rules and Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club, Suite 400, 200 Ronson Drive, Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9.
- 2. If entering directly to the Test Secretary, entries must be typewritten or clearly printed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms. The Wild Rose Hunting Retriever Club does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information or errors due to illegibility of information on any entry form. Make cheques payable to the Wild Rose Hunting Retriever Club.
- 3. Entry fees will not be refunded after 600 P.M., Sunday, June 27,2021. In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee or the Canadian Kennel Club, or because it has been entered incorrectly, or if it is impossible to open or complete the test, no refund of entry will be made.
- 4. In the event of a mail strike, please courier or hand deliver entries to the Test Secretary prior to the closing date.
- 5. No POST-DATED cheques will be accepted.
- 6. Post entries will not be accepted.
- 7. Running order will be available after shortly afterwards and emailed to all participants before the tests.
- 8. Bitches in season shall <u>not</u> be eligible for entry and shall not be allowed on the test grounds.
- 9. Ducks and pheasants may be used in all stakes. Pigeons may be used for the upland hunting test in the Master Hunt Tests. Wingers may be used in any stake.
- 10. Tests will be run at separate locations.
- 11. All throwers, Judges and competitors should wear dark or camouflaged clothing.
- 12. Any dog not appearing within 15 minutes of being called to the line by the Marshall may be disqualified.
- 13. You are responsible for your own lunch.
- 15. Entry and TCN fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of estrus, injury, illness or death shall be refunded in full. An appropriate veterinary certificate must be given to the Test Secretary BEFORE the start of the test to qualify for a refund. All other refunds must be requested in writing within 14 days of the event, explaining the reason for the scratch. Scratches will be refunded at the discretion of the Hunt Test Committee, all but a fee of \$15.00.
- 16. Effective Jan.1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an event registration number (ERN). Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN number, send a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/Mastercard number. Provide your complete address for return of ERN number. Cost \$63.90. ERN numbers must be applied for within 30 DAYS of the FIRST day of entering a CKC event.
- 17. The Wild Rose Hunting Retriever Club and its members will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, BUT will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident, injury or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 18. Electric Collars (either dummy or live) as well as prong or pinch type collars shall not be worn by any dog on the test grounds at any time during the event.
- 19. There shall be no training of dogs on the test grounds, except for single training bumpers, which are thrown by hand by the trainer, within 24 hours of the commencement of the event or anytime during the event.
- 20. Drive only on designated roads or areas on test grounds and pick up trash.
- 21. WRHRC reserves the right to substitute and/or replace judges due to circumstances beyond their control.
- 22. Alcoholic Beverages Are NOT ALLOWED on the Test Grounds!
- 23. All qualifying dogs will receive a rosette.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY: The Wild Rose Hunting Retriever Club (WRHRC), the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC), and the owners of the Field Test grounds, and adjoining property are not responsible for any damages and/or injuries sustained to humans, animals, and/or property while on the Hunt Test grounds or traveling to or from the Hunt Test grounds. All participants, spectators, and guests recognize that this is an outdoor gunning event and attend at their own risk and agree to hold harmless CKC, their officers, the Hunt Test Committee, WRHRC, and the Property Owners/Operators from any and all claims of personal property, loss, damages, and/or injury.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Any person participating in any capacity at a Hunt Test or Working Certificate Test held under the CKC rules and regulations shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the tests and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Wild Rose Hunting Retriever Club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. On report to the Wild Rose Hunting Retriever Club of an alleged indignity of any kind the Test Chairman will report the infringement to the CKC, and the Test Committee shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall have the power to take action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.

To follow current Alberta Health Regulations due to Covid-19 there will be restrictions in place during the event. Please respect all guidelines to ensure we keep everyone safe.

IF YOU FEEL at all UNWELL, in ANY way...PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND.

Any attendees exhibiting symptoms will not be allowed on the grounds.

- 1. Do you have any of the following symptoms:
 - a. A fever
 - b. A cough that is new or different from usual if you have a chronic cough
 - c. A sore throat that is not related to a pre-existing condition
 - d. A runny nose that is not related to a pre-existing condition
 - e. Nasal congestion that is not related to a pre-existing condition
 - f. Shortness of breath that is not related to a pre-existing condition
- 2. Have you travelled internationally within the last 14 days?
- 3. Have you come into contact with individuals who have a confirmed or presumptive diagnosis of COVID-19.

COVID Hunt Test Information

These guidelines may be altered or amended before the test, as per current AHS recommendations.

- All handlers will be notified to go directly to the site of their stake and avoid all congregating in central areas. Parking Please leave more space between your vehicles, within reason or as directed from the Marshall at each stake.
- Social distancing practices will be in place. Be mindful when speaking with others. Don't be offended if someone reminds you to step back!
- While the test dog is running, please be very conscious of not crowding the line. Individually, you can come up to the running line to look at the test. Please wait your turn and do not move to the line until the previous person is over 2 meters away.
- All participants need to bring ALL their own supplies, which includes food and drinks. Bring your own water and soap for hand washing and your own hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes. We will have some hand sanitizer and wipes on the grounds, but people should also plan to provide for themselves.
- Remove all your garbage from the grounds. There will NOT be garbage bins available.
- Bring your own duck call and whistle. We will NOT supply them and absolutely no sharing.
- You will be required to place the bird in the bucket and/or on the drying rack. Judges will NOT be required to take the bird from the handler. If the judge needs to check a bird, they will do so after the handler has left the line.
- Bring your own mask and gloves (if you choose to wear them). If handlers choose to wear rubber gloves to the line, they must dispose of the gloves after leaving the line and put on new gloves with each ensuing series. If handlers choose to wear a mask to the line, they cannot touch the mask to move it up or down to use their whistle. This is equivalent to touching their face/mouth and MUST sanitize their hands immediately.
- There will be a designated area for the gallery. Please maintain the 2 meters distance from anyone who is not in your household or in your social bubble.
- There will be only one port-a-podi available and located at headquarters. Supplies will be located by the port-a-podi for sanitizing. Please follow the guildines that will be posted.
- If you have any questions, they must be directed to the Marshal. Please do not come to talk to the judges at the line.
- If possible, only the handler of the dog should attend the event. This helps to keep attendance numbers low and reduce the risk.
- A hand hygiene sanitizer will be set up at each stake between the last holding blind and the line. The station will include a hand pump bottle of hand sanitizer.
