THE PURPOSE OF THIS POLICY IS TO FURTHER EXPLAIN AND AUGMENT THE POLICES STATED IN OUR BYLAWS (DATED April 16, 2025) OF THE WILD ROSE HUNTING RETREIVER CLUB

POLICY FOR MEMBERSHIP BRINGING NON-MEMBER(S) / GUESTS ONTO CLUB GROUNDS

This policy is being developed so that all members have a clear guideline / understanding as what is expected of them when bringing a non-member / guest onto club grounds.

Since 2019 the Club has had a guest waiver that needs to be filled out and sent to the current Membership Director. Please reference Appendix A of this document.

The goal of bringing a guest onto club grounds is to see if they are interested in the sport of the hunting retriever breed.

- Members submitting a guest waiver must be in good standing with the WRHRC. The guest waiver can be found on our website under the Members Only section.
- No more than 2 guests are allowed at any one time whether it be a single member or a group of members sending in the guest waiver. If a group of members are training, only one person can send in the guest waiver.
- The guest that is being invited onto club grounds to train may have no more the 2 dogs.
- Once the guest waiver has been submitted to the Membership Director, that person will acknowledge receipt.
- The guest waiver must be completed each time a guest accompanies a member(s) onto the grounds.
- Members may bring that one guest to Club Grounds twice. After that guest has been to the club ground twice, they will need to apply for club membership.
- Those guests must stay with the members and train together. They are not allowed to go off on the grounds and train on their own.
- If found that a member, or a group of members, has brought a guest onto club grounds without a guest waiver being submitted, the repercussions will be automatic removal from the club and those involved will not be able to reapply for club membership for two years.

Furthermore, we also encourage members to bring their families to help them train. In this case no waiver is required, but they are required to always stay with you and not go walking off on their own.
