Communications Drill

2024 Summer Gator Fire Games

Objective:

This event allows the teams of four to demonstrate effective communication during a stressful situation. All four cadets will start at a table facing the wall with 15 puzzle pieces in front of them face down. On the "Go" command they can flip the cards over and will have to communicate to figure out which apparatus from the list they can build. To be able to complete the puzzle each cadet will need to have 2 puzzle pieces from the matching apparatus. No cadet will have more than 2 puzzle pieces from each apparatus. Each apparatus picture will be cut into 8 equal pieces.

Each cadet can only bring two puzzle pieces to the middle judging table, once all team members are at the judging table and the puzzle is complete they will sit down in chairs at the table and time will stop. If incorrect pieces are brought to the middle judging table the incorrect pieces must be taken back and swapped out by the cadet, penalty to be assessed.

Requirements:

- Each Post can enter a maximum of three teams consisting of four Cadets/Explorers.
- No Cadet/Explorer can participate in this event twice.

Rules:


- 1. Must not flip cards over on your table until the "Go" command is given.
- 2. Each team member can only bring two pieces to the middle table. If they brought an incorrect piece, they must take the wrong pieces back to their table and then bring the correct ones. (Each wrong piece brought to the middle table is a 15 second penalty)
- 3. You can not show your puzzle pieces to other team members, and you may not attempt to look at another cadets' pieces. (30 second penalty)
- 4. All team members must sit down in the chairs to stop their time.
- 5. Maximum 3-minute time limit

Scoring:

• Fastest time wins after penalties are assessed

*Note- The picture attached is just to help illustrate how the picture and each cadet would have two pieces to help complete the picture. (The sections are just shown in a shaded color to help you understand, during the compentation the pictures will not be shaded like that.)







Visual Barrier
