Mesa Verde Getting a Concrete Patio

The Friends has been working toward installing a concrete slab in the patio area on the north side of the Mesa Verde Library. After a long wait, it is finally going to happen. Soon! Our plan has received city approval and we have contracted a company to do the work. This patio will provide much needed additional space for children and adult programs, book clubs and for people to enjoy internet access while outside.
