Patio Project Ribbon Cutting at Mesa Verde

Vivian Strabala, the Branch Manager of the Mesa Verde Library, has very much wanted to be able to have outdoor programs on the patio outside the Children's section of the library. Because of the way the original space was designed, it was not conducive or safe for either child or adult programs. Bob Ooten met several times with the city and outside contractors to get the project approved. The contractor removed the old concrete and installed wall to wall new concrete on the patio and in the entrance walkway. The Friends paid for this work and has purchased planters and plants to enhance the space. The city is currently working hard cleaning and painting the area. Books by Mail – a free service that delivers books and audiobooks on CD through the US Postal Service to homebound, eligible residents in Orange County who are unable to visit the library because of a physical disability, long-term illness, and/or lack of transportation. Zip Books – This is a new grant program funded by the California State Library. The Zip Book program delivers books (print or audio) directly to patrons free and directly from Amazon. Items must be available from Amazon and not available from OCPL. Items are returned to branches.
