Curbside hours at Donald Dungan Library and Mesa Verde Library are Tuesday through Friday from 12 – 6pm and Saturday 10am – 4pm until further notice. You will be notified when your items are available for contactless curbside pickup. Please call your local branch during Curbside hours for more details.



Library bookdrops are open and available. These are open all hours for library returns. Please note that we cannot accept any donations at this time, we thank you for your understanding.
