GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

CARROLL COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT

The following information must be submitted to the Carroll County Conservation District and/or postmarked by **11:59pm on Wednesday, April 1, 2026**.

1. Completed application form.
2. Current High School grade transcripts.
3. Letter to the Carroll County Conservation District Board regarding your career plans and intended field of study, and why you feel deserving of this scholarship. Please submit typewritten, double-spaced, on not more than two pages.
4. Two letters of recommendation from school officials or community leaders, not to include relatives.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicants must be Carroll County residents.
2. High school students planning to enter college in the fall of 2026 are eligible to apply.
3. Applicants must be enrolled in or intend to enter a program of study directly related to agriculture or conservation.
4. Applicants must have a grade point average of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale.
5. If, for any reason, the scholarship recipient does not attend college, the scholarship must be returned to be awarded to another qualified applicant.
