Do you have invasive Bradford Pear trees on your Carroll County property? This fast-growing species harms local ecosystems—but now, you can help remove them and get paid for it!


How It Works

Remove qualifying Bradford Pear trees from your Carroll County property and earn:

Tree Diameter	Reimbursement Amount
2-4 inches	\$25.00/tree
4+ inches	\$50.00/tree

 **Household Max - \$200**
repeat participation
requires prior approval

 Random, in-person inspections may be performed to verify removal and proper documentation


 **Why It Matters**
Callery Pear trees crowd out native species and create dense thickets that disrupt habitats. Removing them improves land health and supports biodiversity in our community.

Requirements


- Carroll County residency
- Before and after photos submitted
- Small invasive saplings (under 2 inches) in the target area are also expected to be cleared
