Overview



The Carroll County Conservation District is a subdivision of state government and is funded by Carroll County Fiscal Court general funds and direct aid from the State of Kentucky. CCCD is also a prospective recipient of funds from Kentucky Agricultural Development Fund (KADF), environmental grants from the Division of Conservation (DOC), and National Association of Conservation Districts (NACD). CCCD policies and projects are overseen by a Board of Supervisors elected by the community. CCCD is a Special Purpose Government Entity (SPGE) and complies with finance reporting and registration with the Department of Local Government (DLG).

Conservation districts engage people with voluntary actions that keep our air, water, soil, habitats, and farmland healthy for all. Districts are community-based hubs of natural resource expertise and funding

Conservation districts are staffed and led by local professionals who understand the needs of landowners and fellow community members that they serve.

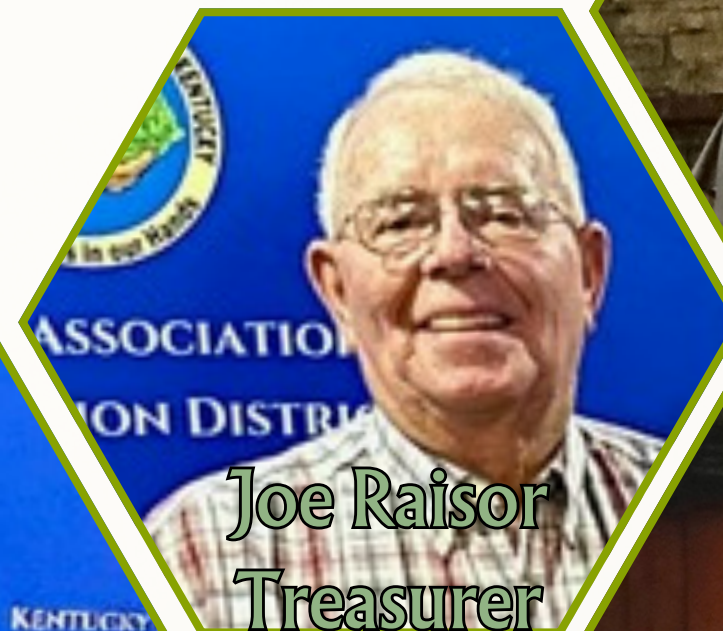

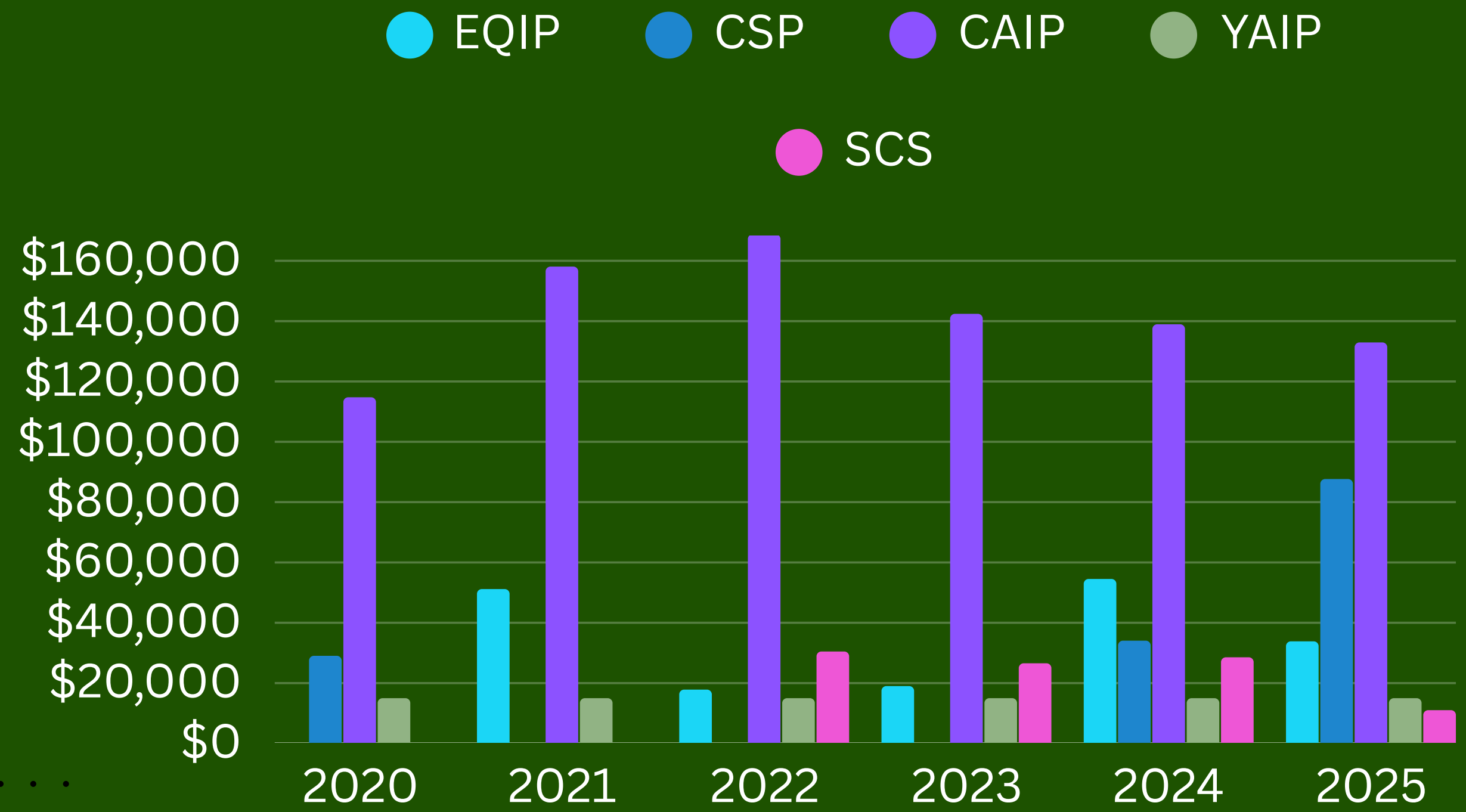

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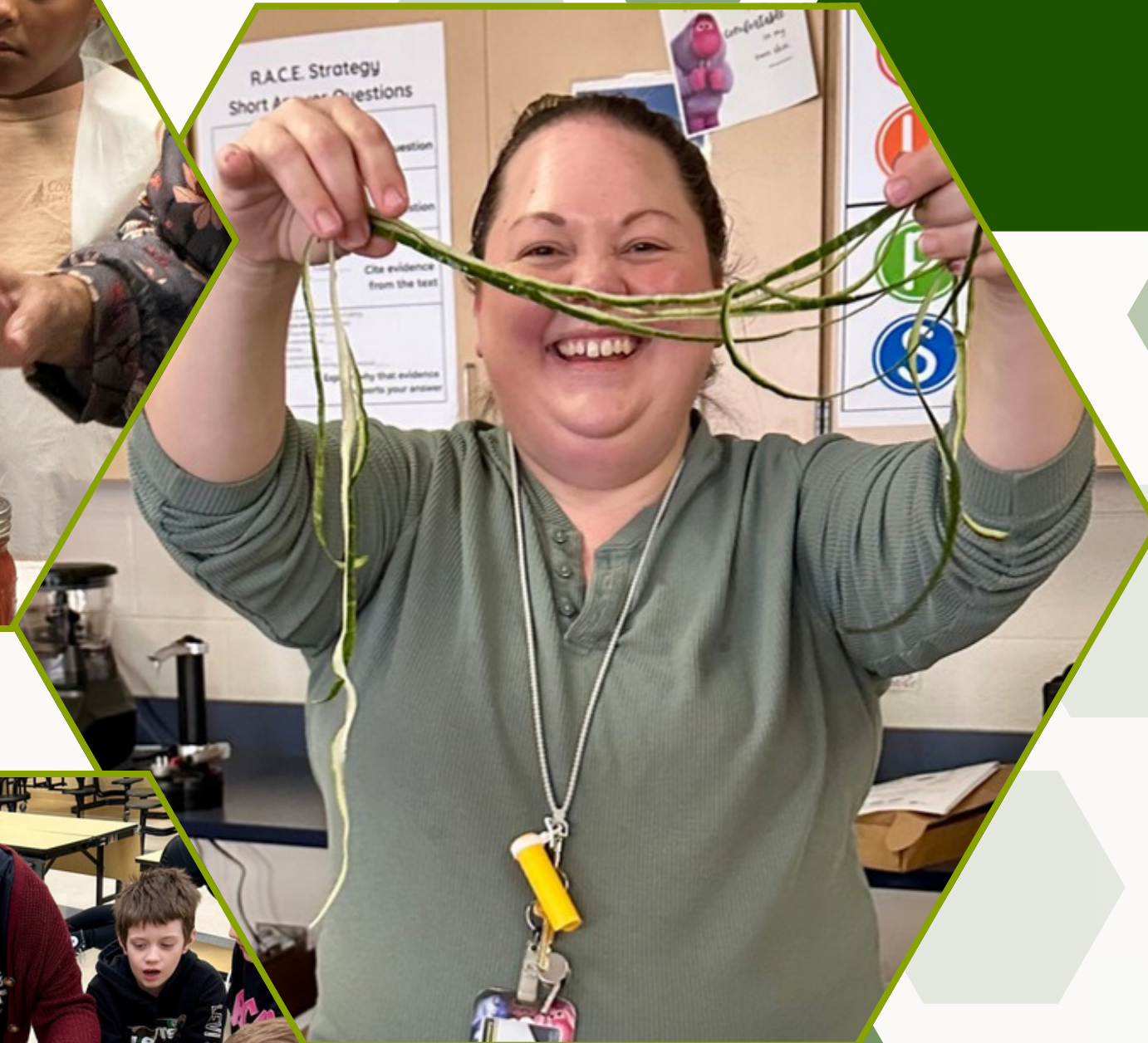
