



Charity Day Recipes

White Bean Chili:

1 1/2 to 2 lbs of cooked, cubed chicken

(I use boneless chicken breast)

2 tbl minced garlic

2 small or 1 large onion, chopped

1 (4oz can) green chilies

1 (48 oz jar) Great Northern beans drained and rinsed

1 (28 oz can) chicken broth

2 tsp cumin

2 tsp oregano

1/8 tsp cayenne pepper (optional)

Saute garlic and onion in butter in large pot. Add cubed chicken and saute until chicken is no longer pink. Put chcken, onion and garlic into crock pot. Add remaining ingredients. Cook 2 to 3 hours.

Charity Day Recipes - Vegetable Chili


- 2 (15 1/2 oz cans) kidney beans
- 1 (15 1/2 oz can) pinto beans
- 1 (28 oz can) whole tomatoes, chopped
- 1 1/2 cups chopped celery
- 1 cup chopped onion
- 1 cup chopped zucchini
- 1 (4 oz can) chopped green chilies
- 1 (12 oz can) tomato paste
- 2 TBL sugar
- 1 bay leaf
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 Tbl chili powder
- 1/2 tsp garlic powder
- 1 tsp marjoram
- 1/4 tsp red cayenne pepper (Optional)

Tabasco sauce (Optional)

In large sauce pan, sauté onions in small amount of water till tender. Add zucchini and celery.

Continue to sauté for a couple minutes. Add remaining ingredients and bring to boil.

Reduce heat and simmer 30-35 minutes

New Business:


- The May Board meeting will be held at Bev.'s home.

For VP Scheduling	During the 2010-2011 term of office, seeks out and schedules guest speakers and workshop leaders for the 2011-2012 guild year. Works with Programming committee
For VP Membership	Chairs the membership Committee whose members maintain membership records, produce the directory, receive and process membership applications and keep all membership records current
For Recording Secretary	Takes minutes at all meetings and maintains a file of those minutes
For Corresponding Secretary	Maintains a file of all correspondence, shares pertinent correspondence with members, handles correspondence as directed by the board.
For Treasurer	Is the custodian of the guild's funds and records, prepares annual budget. Pays expenses, does the banking for the Guild and gives a financial report at each meeting.
