INSTRUCTIONS FOR REGISTERING A QUILT IN THE 2022 CAMEO QUILT SHOW

1. Thank you for entering your guilt in the 2022 CAMEO Quilt Show.

Fill in one registration form for each quilt item submitted. Your quilt will be assigned a registration number. **RETURN THIS FORM ON OR BEFORE APRIL 1, 2022 TO LAURIE JOHNSON.** (Quilts do not need to be completed until April 20, 2022).

- 2. Entries submitted by non-CAMEO Guild members must include a \$5.00 entry fee.
- 3. You will be given a receipt for each quilt submitted with its Registration number.
- 4. Each guilt must have an I.D. label sewn on the back to include the Quilt Title and Registrant's Name.
- 5. Quilts larger than 42" square must have a five inch finished sleeve on the back for hanging. Any quilt smaller than 42" will be pinned for hanging
- 6. Quilts may be hung by entry classification, such as bed size quilts, challenge quilts, wall hanging, etc. Please check **only one** category for each entry on the front of this form.
- 7. Quilts can be dropped off on Thursday April 21, 2022 from 9:00 to 4:00 at the American Polish Cultural Center, 2975 E. Maple Road (at Dequindre) Troy, MI 48083.
- 8. The quilt show will end at 4:00 p.m. Saturday, April 23, 2022. Quilts can be picked up from the Registration and Receiving committee once all the quilts are taken down between 4:30 to 5:30.

You need to bring your receipt with the Registration information to claim your quilt.

If you cannot pick up your quilt and are asking someone else to pick it up, please inform the Receiving Committee Chairpersons ahead of time. Only the Registrants will be able to pick up their quilts unless arrangements have been made in advance. See page 1 of registration form.

QUILT CATEGORIES AND TERMS (for hanging purposes)

CATEGORIES:

Bed Quilts: Designed to be used as a bed covering or throw. Crib quilts, lap quilts, quilts for

youth beds, and other small bed quilts are included in this category

Wall Hangings: Designed to be hung for decorative purposes

Small Quilts/ Home Dec: Includes fabric postcards or home dec items like pillows, table runners,

tote bags, purses, clothing, etc.

TECHNIQUES:

Pieced: Quilts more than 50 percent pieced by hand or machine Appliqué: Quilts more than 50 percent appliquéd by hand or machine

Mixed: Any guilts that are a combination of piecing and appliqué and /or other techniques so that less

than 50 percent of the guilt is pieced or appliquéd

Other: Any quilts that do not fit into the pieced or appliquéd categories: such as whole cloth, crazy quilt,

redwork, embroidered, stenciled, painted, etc.

QUILTING:

Hand: Must be entirely quilted by hand. No machine quilting permitted

Machine: Quilted on a domestic sewing machine

Long-arm: Quilted on a commercial quilting machine; either free-motion or computer quided

Mixed: Hand and machine techniques
