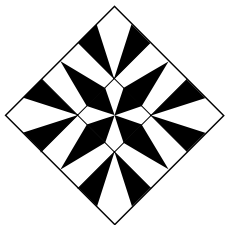


Rooms" and "Twelve Etiquette Essentials: Formal Dining and Tea Time."

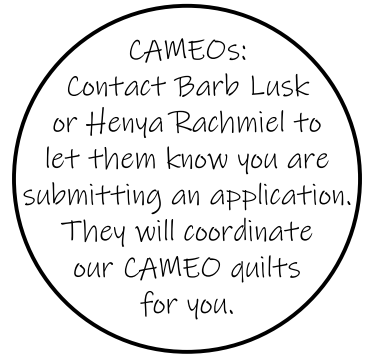
