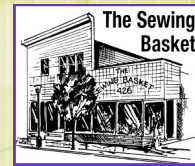


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Sewing with Cuddle Tip Sheet

Sewing for the fun of it!



Cuddle fabric is irresistibly soft!

It is great to use for quilts or garments.

These simple tips will make sewing this fun fabric easier.

- Do not use fabric softener
- Do not iron, texture will be lost if ironed. Finger press or use a "wooden" iron if needed.
- Machine wash and dry on medium
- Fabric will "shed" when cutting. We cut our pieces and then take them outside and shake them until they stop shedding.
- Sew with a 3/8" or more seam allowance. Since the fabric is polyester it will stretch and a 1/4" seam allowance is very hard to sew.
- Sew using your walking or even feed foot to help control stretch.
- When piecing, cut the longest dimension in the same direction as the non-stretch side.
