

Class Name: What a Deal Purse Retreat

Date: June 3, 4, 5 (9:30—4:30)

Place/Time: Studio B—Park in back lot and enter back door

Description: In this retreat you will learn to create purses. You can make whatever you want, but the basic instruction will follow the purse card pattern. It makes a great reference and inspiration guild for future purses and totes also.

We will do a demo the first 2 days at 10 am and 1:30 pm. The 4 demos will be on: construction, handles, zippers and pockets, flaps and closures.

Pattern or book: What a Deal Purse Card pattern. Due to copyright laws each student must have their own copy of the pattern.

Fabric Requirements: 1/2 yard exterior, 1/2 yard interior, 1/2 yard handles and pockets. I suggest you bring a variety of coordinating fabrics. Most purses can be made "scrappy" with a total of about 1 1/2 yards. More fabrics are required for multiple pockets and other options.

Other Project Supplies:

Interfacing, batting or foam about 1 yard—this will depend on what you decide to make. We have them all available here and we'll be discussing the pros and cons of each during the retreat. Bring what you have.
