Every 2 hours someone in PA dies from a drug overdose.

In PA there are 299,000 estimated individuals with a drug disorder.

In 2012 there were 2132 overdose cases. It had increased 241% to 5146 in 2022, 84% opioid related & 78.4% from fentanyl.

Fayette County PA is the 5th worst county for overdoses.

Residents of the Appalachian region are 60% more likely to die from drug overdose than residents of the rest of the US.
