COPPERFIELD HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION POOL RULES / RESTRICTIONS

- All residents and guests swim at their own risk.
- The Association and the lifeguards are NOT responsible for any injury.
- **ONLY COPPERFIELD RESIDENTS** with 2025 wristbands and their guests (limit 5 per household) are permitted.
- Anyone under the age of twelve (12) years must be accompanied by someone 16 (sixteen) years or older.
- No glass objects, glass containers or glass will be allowed in the pool.
- All residents (Pool Members) must sign-in Name, Address, and Time-in and Time-out.
 Comply with General Social Distancing Guidelines currently in place.
- Guests **must shower before** entering the pool.
- Resident(s) cannot be in the pool facility if they are sick or have any open wounds/sores.
- Please wash hands before entering the pool facility, even if you do not intend to swim.
- No Running, rough housing or other disorderly conduct (including vulgar language) is prohibited
- No diving except in the deep end of the pool and with lifeguard permission.
- At the lifeguard's discretion swimmers may be asked to pass a swimming proficiency test before being allowed in the deep end of the pool
- Observe all posted rules on signs posted in the pool area.
- Lifeguard / Northwest Pool Management decisions are final.
- If the lifeguard has a situation that required HOA involvement, they will contact Pool Chair, Clyde Moore (405) 641-5546 or Co-Pool Chair, Trevor Taylor
- Any failure to comply with rules or Lifeguard instructions will result in immediate action. This can include the guest immediately being told to leave the pool area, temporary suspension or revocation of pool privileges for the season.

CODE OF ORDINANCES
TITLE 8. OFFENSES AND NUISANCES

ORDINANCE NO. 3688

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUCNIL OF THE CITY OF EDMOND. OKALHOMA:

SECTION 1. Chapter 4.16 of the Edmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Chapter 4.16 Canvassers, Solicitors, and Peddlers

Section 4.16.010 License Required.

It shall be unlawful for any canvasser, **solicitor**, or peddler as defined in Section 4.16.020 of this chapters to engage in such business within the corporate limits of the City of Edmond without first obtaining a license therefor in compliance with the provisions of this chapter...

§ 8.24.010. Public nuisances defined.

- (j) The continued making of **loud or unusual noises** which annoy persons of ordinary sensibilities; or the keeping of an **animal** which makes such noises.
- **(o)** Rand **weeds or grass**, carcasses, accumulations of manure, refuse or other things, which are, or are likely to be, breeding places for flies, mosquitoes, vermin or disease germs.

Any of the above acts shall constitute a public nuisance and shall be abated as set out in Edmond Municipal Code <u>Section</u> 8.24.030 Abatement of Public Nuisances.

§8.28.010. Trash and Weeds Prohibited.

It shall be unlawful to allow the accumulation of trash or the growth of weeds upon any property to include adjoining alleyways, street rights-of-way, or easements in the City of Edmond.
