

On May 2, 1998, God prophetically established Elder Johnie L. Evans as the Assistant Pastor of Bibleway Fellowship Center and, therefore, the one to succeed Founding Pastor Eugene Cooper in fulfilling the church's mission. Pastor Cooper continued in his pastoral role until his passing in 2008. Thereafter, Pastor Evans and Elect Lady Freddie L. Evans commenced their head leadership roles at Bibleway. Elect Lady served for eleven years until she transitioned on November 27, 2019. Pastor Evans celebrates his sixteenth anniversary this year. The Evanses were married for forty-five years. They have three children and six grandchildren.

CHURCH HISTORY

Bibleway Fellowship Center was founded Thursday, December 26, 1996, by Pastor Eugene Cooper with twenty-five members. The first service was held at the Coopers' residence on the following Sunday—December 29, 1996. The church was officially deemed a non-profit on May 2, 1997. On Saturday, May 2, 1998, Bibleway's members witnessed the groundbreaking of its present-day sanctuary. Bibleway was dedicated during a climax service held on April 14, 2002. Pastor Cooper served in his role for almost twelve years until he was called home on July 27, 2008. Pastor Johnie Evans succeeded him as the shepherd of the church.
