



PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED: Use link below to pre-register for the show and provide all label information. Your name, the name of your artwork, the medium and the price will be on the label that will be attached to your artwork on the delivery date.

Pre-Registration deadline: Midnight, Wednesday, May 31st.

*MUST PRE-REGISTER: <u>REGISTRATION LINK HERE</u> There is NO FEE.

Rules of Entry: Artists must have membership in good standing. Limited to 3 (three) entries per artist. Work must be framed safely and wired for hanging. No clip frames. Gallery wrap canvas acceptable (no visible staples).

Maximum size: 40" in all directions, including frame. Wt. Limit: 15 lbs.

Commission & Sales: The Gallery of the Virtua Health Foundation will receive a 30% commission. Payments will be made directly to the Gallery Credit Union Office (located next to the gallery). The Gallery will furnish the artists with an accounting within 30 (thirty) days after the close of the exhibition. No additional B.C.A.G. commission.

Loss & Damage: The Gallery shall be responsible for the safekeeping of all consigned artwork and will be liable for loss or damage. *No work can be removed before pick up schedule, without previous arrangements with Francis Ridolfo.*
