#### Shadow Weave Towels in Green Teal Mystery Yarn by Ellen Land-Weber



The project was to use up some of my mystery cones of yarn acquired pretty cheaply from estate sales and make useful items for donation to the Guild and for future gifts to friends and family.

The green teal is fairly hefty, probably 5/2 mercerized cotton, the white is definitely 6/2 cotton. I used a draft from Marion Powell's "1000+ Patterns in Shadow Weave" which allowed for a different treadling for each towel. There were 12 to choose from! I had enough warp to weave 6 towels.

I am a bit disappointed that the towels are not as absorbent as those I have woven in unmercerized cotton. Looking up the differences of mercerized vs. unmercerized, I learned a lot about why their absorbency properties are different. I am going to follow the advice of several weavers that repeated washings will improve their absorbency.

Meanwhile I am going to "transcribe" another of Powell's drafts, per Linda Hartshorn' useful guide, and make another set of towels in a different color combination. I used up almost all of the green teal cone. Yeah! On to another!
