Rag rugs are fun and easy! Weave two small rugs or one larger one in this class. Choose from one of the many plain weave variations, such as striped, clasped weft, and log cabin, or weave a twill rug. Learn different ways to prepare your rags, using new fabric or recycling old textiles. Finish your rug with a hem or plied fringe.
