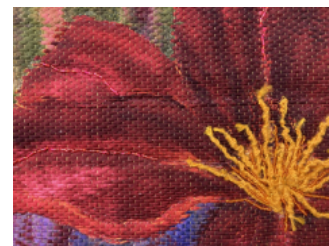

**Theme and Variation:  
More Weaving That Sings**  
a history of the Theo Moorman inlay technique  
*with Nadine Sanders*



This presentation explains the creative weave structure with the unusual name that uses two sizes of warp to achieve design inlay on the surface of the fabric. Nadine's weaving exploration has focused on the Moorman technique and its variations to explore materials, texture, form, and to express meaning. Nadine will present images of this technique from weavers from around the world in clothing, rugs, wall hangings and home furnishings.

Nadine teaches because she loves helping students realize their creative potential.

Nadine skillfully organizes [Threads, Ruins and Tunes tours](#) in Scotland. Small groups explore Scotland and visit the Outer Hebrides and Orkney Islands.

Nadine and mentor [Joyce Harter](#) wrote two books on the Theo Moorman weaving technique. Nadine created the DVD and companion booklet *Warping on a Shoestring*. She studied fiber arts at Oregon School of Arts and Crafts, Portland, OR. and Public Address at St. Olaf College, Northfield, MN.
