# Papermaking with Lori Goodman



Learn about Lori's papermaking and sculpture process. Lori will show us around her studio and share images of her work from over many years.

Bio: I began as a weaver about 53 years ago in Los Angeles. Upon moving to Humboldt County in 1973 I began spinning, dyeing, raising sheep and children (just 2). My friend, Terry Hill and I then opened the Woolmark, a fiber art supply store in Eureka, because we couldn't find the weaving and spinning supplies we wanted for our craft. For 15 years we taught weaving, spinning, knitting, sold looms, wheels, yarn and fleece. At some point I started making paper and giving workshops. I immediately loved paper. It was immediate and much easier to manipulate and work with than the weaving. Plus if a mistake is made paper can quickly be recycled and reused. The rest is history. I still love the process of making paper and creating sculptures out of it.
