Fiber Arts Travelogue: Shetland Wool Week 2023 with Angelina Gregorio



This presentation will include a discussion and slide show of Angelina's recent trip to the Shetland Islands to attend the 13th annual Shetland Wool Week. The Islands have a long and fascinating history of raising sheep and producing wool, leading to a refined level of lace knitting and other specialized techniques. The presentation will focus on Wool Week, but also feature explorations of the Islands and the inspiring people who work to keep these traditions alive.

Angelina learned to knit and crochet at an early age, dabbling through the years, but only dove deep into fiber arts after retiring.

News from the Weaving Studio

The Ink People are moving to a new location when their lease expires in June and will not be taking the Weaving Studio with them. Leslie Castellano, the director, said the reason is the studio is not one of their "core programs" and that it does not generate much money per square foot.

This is very unexpected as weaving classes have been happening at the Ink People for the past 30 years. It is a rare and valuable resource and an integral part of our fiber and arts community.

We hope to find another (free or very low cost) space for the looms. The Weaving Studio will become a program of HHSG, who can provide insurance and non-profit status.
