Plan a lace towel or other towel project - include extra towels for fair sales and a towel exchange.

Participants should share their notes about the project - pattern draft, yarn, sett etc. with possibly a small swatch or photo for all participants to receive.

The participants will gift a towel or two to the guild sales table. Towels can be entered in the County Fair as wished. Lace towels can be included in the lace display by the fiber circle.

Extra towels for the exchange - participants can meet and figure out how they'd like to exchange the extra towels they brought in October or November. All participants receive the project notes.

Finished towel sizes are usually 15.5" by 26" long. (on loom 16" x 28")

Hope this sounds like a plan to get some members started weaving! I have a painted warp that I'll combine with huck lace structure as my towel project. Off to start threading now...
