CURRENT PROJECTS

MAINSTREET BRANDING & THE GREAT BLOCKS PROJECT

We're developing a consistent brand identity that captures the spirit of Grants MainStreet—including new logos, messaging, and visuals that tell our district's story. Additionally, we've launched the Great Blocks Project, focused on redesigning Santa Fe Avenue in the MainStreet district to improve walkability, beautification, and pedestrian experience.

WAYFINDING

Our Wayfinding Project will enhance signage throughout downtown and the greater Grants area, with a special focus on outdoor recreation wayfinding to highlight trails, parks, and landmarks. This effort will make Grants more walkable, welcoming, and visitor-friendly.

TREE RISK ASSESSMENT

We're working with certified arborists to assess the health and safety of downtown trees. This initiative ensures a safer environment while planning for future tree plantings and green space improvements.

BOOMS TRACKER

The Business Occupancy and Opportunities Management System (BOOMs Tracker) monitors downtown vacancies and helps us identify new business opportunities, pop-up concepts, and expansion potential. It's an essential tool driving our economic development efforts.

BUSINESS RECRUITMENT & EXPANSION PROJECT

We're actively working to recruit new businesses to the MainStreet district while supporting the growth of existing ones. This project uses data-driven strategies to identify service gaps and collaborate with entrepreneurs to fill them.

CABOOSE BRICK PLANTER BOXES

As part of the Caboose Brick Initiative, new brick planter boxes are being installed in front of City Hall. These planters incorporate engraved bricks purchased by individuals, families, and businesses to honor their connection to Grants' history and community spirit.

FACADE REVITALIZATION PROJECT

Thanks to funding from the New Mexico Resiliency Alliance and the Walmart SPARKS Grant, we're refreshing the facades of 9 downtown buildings. We're also working with one business on new signage to further enhance the downtown aesthetic.

Special thanks to Diamond G for their generous support with paint and supplies—allowing us to expand this project with the help of community volunteers.
