## WAYFINDING PROJECT UPDATE

### Wayfinding

With the wayfinding survey now complete, we are moving into the conceptual design phase. The next step is the development of a comprehensive design portfolio that will provide clear, prioritized recommendations for future improvements.

This work will guide a long-term strategy to replace, add, and upgrade wayfinding throughout the MainStreet District and the City of Grants, enhancing navigation, community identity, and the overall visitor experience.

#### The design portfolio will include:

- Recommended sign locations
- Sign types and hierarchy
- Visual and branding standards
- Material selection and durability guidance
- Installation considerations
- Phased cost estimates
- Funding strategies, including grants, local budgets, and TIF/MainStreet programs

This phased and strategic approach ensures that future wayfinding investments are cohesive, cost-effective, and aligned with community goals.

### Logo Background

- And much more!

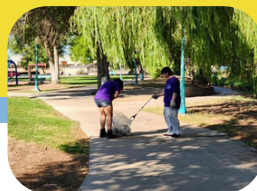
This project is designed to create a dynamic gathering space that celebrates creativity, community, and culture in the heart of Grants.

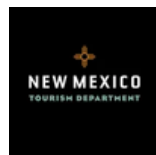
