


NEW FEATURES AND SUBCODE UPDATE - MARCH 2025

Enhancements going live on March 3rd, providing improved visibility and functionality for your instore execution:

- Maximum by-item visibility (Basic Orders)
 - Each item available in the basic ordering module (testers, at-counter materials) now clearly indicates an item maximum based on our volume hierarchy of subcodes that drive the way we allocate and distribute products.




These item maximums have been in place "behind the scenes" to ensure the orders you have placed for your stores were managed within the inventory and budget available. Through our IT partnership, we are now able to make these item maximums visible to you, so you can better manage your monthly support choices.


 The functionality to add or remove items from your cart remains the same, but as you adjust quantities, you will notice that the quantity remaining for each item is reduced accordingly.




When you have a "0" quantity remaining for the item's monthly maximum, you will
no longer be able to add additional quantities of that item.




 You are able to reduce quantities of an item by utilizing the "-" sign, and the remaining quantities adjust accordingly.



 Quantities added to your cart and hitting against the overall store allocation are still tracked via the bar at the top of the page.



 As a reminder, item maximums apply to <u>all</u> items that are part of the basic order dataset. However, only testers count toward the store tester allocation. Ordered quantities of at-counter materials (i.e. disposables or cotton pads) do not count toward the store maximum.



Subcode Updates

We are updating our by-door subcodes (and as a result, the overall store tester allocations) to align with the 2025 by-door sales goals. The hierarchy does not change, but there has been some movement between codes, where business has grown or been challenged. We will update after February month-end processing, so any new assignments would be reflected at that time to meet month of March ordering. Please keep in mind that any orders that have already been created and/or executed by our internal team will reflect the current assignment of subcodes.
