~The Cooperator agrees to pay \$5.00/acre for the use of this equipment and/or materials. The Cooperator shall comply with all federal, state and local laws and ordinances applicable to use of the neglect or abuse resulting to this equipment and /or materials.

~The Cooperator shall indemnify and hold harmless the District and its officers, agents and employees from any and all liability or claims in connection with this agreement or the equipment and/or materials subject to this agreement, including, but not limited to, the selection, delivery, use, operation, or return of such equipment and/or materials.

The Dunn County Soil Conservation District does not guarantee an established grass/crop stand.

The minimum charge for the rental of the drill is \$250.00 nonrefundable.

Acres will be calculated according to the Conservation Plan Maps.

The Cooperator will begin rolling as soon as possible after the land roller has been delivered.

Payment is required at the time this agreement is entered into. The District will hold the Cooperator’s check until the seeding is complete. Thereafter; if the Cooperator roll more or less acres than what is shown on this agreement, the Cooperator will submit a check for the correct amount.

**The producer is required to provide their own pin for transporting the Land Roller.

**The Dunn County SCD reserves the right to refuse service to anyone

IMPORTANT: Recommended speed with the blade attached is 4mph. Without the blade is 10-12mph. ¾ ton pickup to transport the land roller. 150 horsepower (5-6 per foot). All grease zerks must be greased when producer is done rolling. No water is allowed in the drum.
