## **RE: Drill Rental**

If you are interested in renting the drill, **complete the enclosed form, sign, and return** the form to the Dunn County SCD Office along with a copy of a field map with the field and acres highlighted.

You will need to enclose a check for \$300 as a deposit (in addition to a check for your estimated acres). We require that you fill out the check sheet that is enclosed on the drill If this sheet is filled out, sent back, properly clean, and there are no other issues, your \$300 will be returned to you.

On the front of the agreement form, please complete the land description and on the back of the form enter the number of acres intended to be seeded. Also, the district requires that a check for the number of estimated acres be sent along with your rental agreement. So, you will need to send 2 checks back with the agreement. The District will hold your check until seeding has been completed. If you cannot use the drill for some reason, the check will be returned to you.

The minimum charge for the rental of the drill is \$100. If an employee of the DCSCD is available to transport it will be \$12.00 per acre with a minimum of \$50. If an employee is not available to transport it is will \$10.00 per acre.

The renter must transport the drill from the last destination to his or her own field(s) unless Dunn County SCD Employee is able to transport the drill. If you use the drill out of Dunn County, the drill must be brought back into the office in Killdeer. If you are the last renter to use the drill for the season, the drill must be brought into the office in Killdeer.

It is the responsibility of the renter to clean and grease the drill. **There will be a \$300.00 charge added to the rental of the drill if it is not properly cleaned.** 

There are usually several producers on the rental list; so please complete your seeding as soon as possible. The average acreage per day is 50 acres.
