RE: 2017 Ag Shield Land Roller

If you are interested in renting the Land Roller, complete the enclosed form, sign, and return the form to the Dunn County SCD Office along with a copy of a field map with the field and acres highlighted.

You will need to enclose a check for \$500 as a deposit (in addition to a check for your estimated acres). We require that you fill out the check sheet that is provided by the Dunn County SCD. If this sheet is filled out, sent back, and there are no other issues, your \$500 deposit will be returned to you.

On the front of the agreement form, please complete the land description and on the back of the form enter the number of acres intended to be Rolled. Also, the district requires that a check for the amount of estimated acres be sent along with your rental agreement. So you will need to send 2 checks back with the agreement. The District will hold your check until rolling has been completed. If you cannot use the land roller for some reason, the check will be returned to you.

The renter must transport the land roller from the last destination to his or her own field(s) Unless an Dunn County SCD Employee can transport. If you use the land roller out of Dunn County, the land roller must be brought back into the county when you finish with it.

It is the responsibility of the renter to clean and grease the land roller. There will be a \$20.00 charge added to the rental of the land roller if it is not properly cleaned.

There are usually several producers on the rental list; so please complete your rolling as soon as possible. The average acreage per hour is 15 acres at 4mph with blade and 10-12mph without the blade.
