## WHAT IS CROWN CLUB?

The Crown Club is a project of the Junior Auxiliary of Madison County that focuses on creating service opportunities for high school girls in 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th grades. This project encourages the concept of teaching our youth how to give back to their community. These project members work with the girls throughout the year, August to May, to teach them the benefits of community service and to inspire future leaders.



## WHAT IS OUR PURPOSE?

To foster interest among its members in the social, economic, educational, civic and cultural conditions of their community with the goal of developing leadership skills and character while inspiring passion for community service.



## WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

To maintain membership, Crown Club members must:

- ◇ Attend five (5) of the eight (8) regular monthly meetings. The regular meetings are held on the last Sunday afternoon of each month. One hour meeting credit is given for regular club meetings
- ◇ Pay dues of \$45 annually by November meeting
- ◇ Perform a minimum of twelve (12) Crown Club approved service hours in Crown Club projects
- ◇ Obtain three (3) Finance hours by the first of May. Throughout the year, the finance hours can be obtained by donating specified items.
- ◇ Be a Madison County Resident or attend a school in Madison County

Step 1: In the top left hand corner of the site (from a mobile device), go to the Menu—and Select Membership.

Step 2: Select Log Hours

Step 3: Select Log Hours Online in the pink box

Step 4: Sign On to the Website—by using the Login Name and Password given to you at Kick-Off Meeting. If you need your password reset at a later date, you can email [jamccrownclub@gmail.com](mailto:jamccrownclub@gmail.com)—and we will reset you! Be sure to select “Save your Username and Password” so you do not have to sign-in each time.

Step 5: What would you like to do?

- Volunteer Sign-Up—As we have service opportunities, we will send you a link to sign up to work timeslots during a project! We will send via email, as well as post on Crown Club Member GroupMe!

- Log Hours—After Completion—After you have completed a project, you can log your hours on this page by selecting the Project Name—and then Time Sheet to log your hours! **Be sure to select Save and Submit for Approval!!!!** At each project, be sure to physically sign in on the Attendance Sheet when you come and when you leave—so we can verify and approve your hours accordingly! You can see your hours throughout the year anytime on the website to ensure you are on track to meet your annual requirements!
