General Tournament Information

General Tournament Information

- 1.1 Buck Wild Bowhunter Archery Club holds five tournaments and one championship tournament each year. The specific tournament type will vary from time to time. Tournament schedules consisting of dates, times, and type are generally posted to the club's website in early January of each year for the season. Tournaments are held every other month.
- 1.2 Non-championship tournament entry fee is \$20.00 and can be paid in cash or by credit/debit card prior to or at the time of the tournament. Non-championship tournament awards are a club plaque for 1st place and a cash payout. 2nd and 3rd place will receive a club certificate, but a cash payout may or may not be applicable pending number competing archers. Preregistration is required. The length of time registration is open can be found on the club's website in the tournament details.
- 1.3 Championship tournament entry fee is \$25.00 and can be paid in cash or by credit/debit card prior to or at the time of the tournament. Preregistration is required. The length of time registration is open can be found on the club's website in the tournament details. 1/10 of an archer's total season score from the nine tournaments prior to the championship will be added to their championship score as part of determining 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. Awards for the championship are a club plaque for 1st place and a cash payout. 2nd and 3rd place will also receive a club plaque, but a cash payout may or may not be applicable pending number of competing archers. Preregistration is required. The length of time registration is open can be found on the club's website in the tournament details.
- 1.4 Preregistration is set to be super easy. For any tournament, send an email to Buckwildbowhunter@gmail.com or call the club number (936) 337-3003 or text the club number with the following information: 1) Tournament Name 2) Your Name (First and Last), and method of entry fee payment (cash or charge). That is all it takes to be registered for a Buck Wild Bowhunter Archery Club tournament.
- 1.5 NO entry fee refunds unless the tournament is canceled by Buck Wild Bowhunter Archery Club.
- 1.6 Shooter of the Year (SOY) title for the club is determined by the total score from five key tournaments shot over the course of a season. The five specific tournaments are noted on the club's tournament schedule found on the website at www.buckwildbowhunter.com. The club's SOY is awarded a special plaque acknowledging their accomplishment and a custom club SOY belt buckle.

Tournament Location

2.1 Tournaments are held in one of the following locations:

- (1) Buck Wild Bowhunter Archery Club's Range | Huntsville, Texas
- (2) Texas Archery | Spring, Texas

2.2 Venue changes are notified at least five days prior to the listed tournament date/time.

2.3 Location details can be found in each tournament's detail sheet on the club's website.

Tournament Scoring

3.1 During all applicable tournaments double scoring will be utilized and consist of two scorecards or at least one scorecard and another form of score tracking. One scorecard will be designated as the official tournament card to be turned in at the end of the tournament. In the event of a discrepancy between scoring methods that cannot be verified or agreed upon, the lower score will be recorded as official. It is extremely important to verify that both scoring methods match throughout the whole tournament.

3.2 Any arrow shot that does not have a group consensus on the scoring value is determined by the Buck Wild Bowhunter Archery Club's officiating member over the tournament. Officiator's call is final.

3.3 Tie breaker methods are dependent on tournament type. Detail on tie breakers can be found in each tournament's detail sheet on the club's website.

Styles

4.1 Buck Wild Bowhunter Archery Club's primary style is Freestyle (FS) compound. However, if four or more archers preregister in a different style (example: Barebow, Bowhunter, Recurve, etc.) a style for that grouping will be opened with all aspects and standings of Freestyle (FS). The detail of each style follow NFAA definitions.

Divisions

5.1 Buck Wild Bowhunter Archery Club's primary division is adult. However, if four or more archers wish to have a different division, we will open it but, style requirements must be met also.

Equipment Regulations

6.1 Most bow types are permitted, as per NFAA definition, in any Buck Wild Bowhunter Archery Club tournament as long as all division and/or style requirements are met and it poses no safety issue. The exception are crossbows. No crossbows are permitted. Final determination is at the discretion of the Buck Wild Bowhunter Archery Club tournament officiator.

6.1 Only field points or bullet points may be used. Broadheads and practice broadheads are not permitted in any Buck Wild Bowhunter Club tournament.
