What is a 301 Round?

The 301 Round is shot like a traditional game of 301 in Darts with a few minor adjustment to bring it over to the archery world. Details of tournament play are given later in this document.

- Open Division (male and female shoot together)

301 Round Detail

- Target: 40cm Dartboard (paper)
- Range: 20 Yd.
- Rounds: Shooting will continue until first three archers reach a perfect zero.
- Arrows: Three arrows per round.

Progression During Tournament (archers start with 301 points)

Step 1: Each archer shoots three arrows

Step 2: Arrows are scored based on hit locations

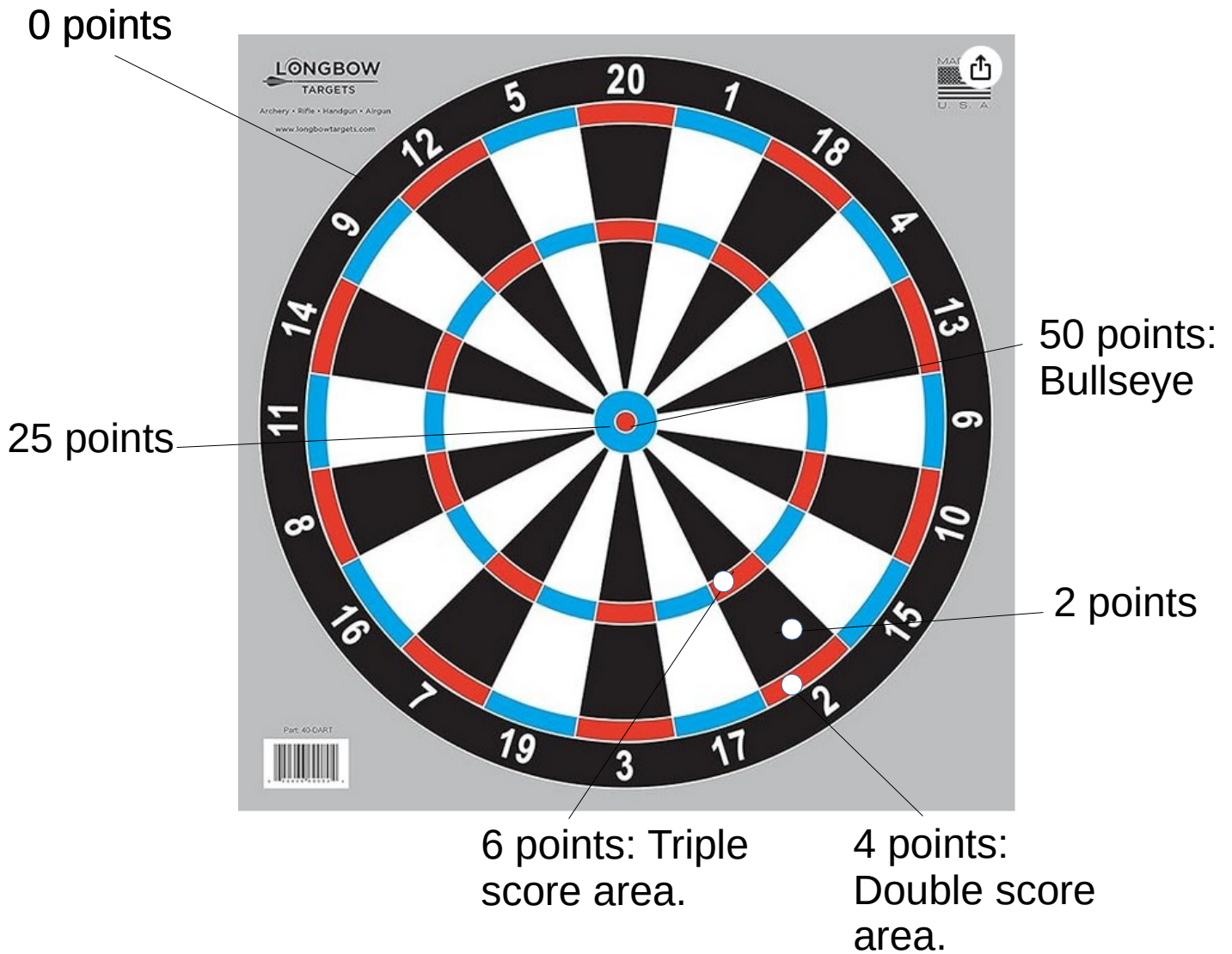
Step 3: Scores are added together and subtracted from 301

The difference becomes your new score

Step 4: Repeat steps one through three until you reach a perfect zero
Perfect zero means if you need a 5 and you score a 6, it does not count and you must continue to shoot.
