April's Full Moon: The Pink Moon

The Full Moon in April is traditionally known as the Pink Moon, a name rooted in the seasonal rhythms of the Earth. This name comes from Native American and Colonial American traditions, where full moons were often named for natural events occurring during the month. The 'Pink Moon' refers not to the moon's color, but to the early spring blooming of wild ground phlox, one of the first flowers to blossom in North America, carpeting the ground in soft pink hues. Historically, this moon marked a time of planting, fertility, and the return of warmth and life after winter's stillness. Across cultures, April's full moon has been associated with themes of renewal, beauty, and balance, aligning, with the energies of growth and transformation that springs. Under the light of the Pink Moon, we are invited to reflect on what is beginning to bloom in our own lives—and to celebrate the cycles of nature that mirror our inner evolution.

Family Ritual: Worm Moon in Virgo

What You'll Need:

Give each person a smooth stone or plece of paper. On it, write or draw one way they can bring more peace or kindness into the home. Place the stones in a circle around the candle as a symbol of unity and intention.



5. Blessing & Connection
Hold hands and say a family blessing, such as:
"May our hearts stay kind. our words stay gentle.
and our home stay filled with love."

End with hugs, laughter, or a song—something joyful to seal the energy of togetherness.

Moonlit Mirror Ritual

Sit with a mirror by candlelight or moonlight and gaze gently into your reflection. Speak affirmations of self-love, balance, and inner harmony aloud. This ritual connects you to Libra's Venusian energy, helping you deepen self-awareness and compassion.

What You'll Need:

- · A pink or white candle
- A small mirror
- A bowl of water
- · A few dried rose petals or a fresh flower
- · A journal or paper and pen

The Waxing Moon teaches us the importance of commitment, consistency, and tending to our intentions so they can grow into their fullest potential by the time the Full Moon arrives.

It's important to consider the sign that the moon falls in when planning rituals, spells, and other magickal workings. Waxing Moon Phases

Waxing Crescent

The Waxing Crescent moon is a powerful time for drawing things toward you and creating a solid action plan to bring your goals to life. This phase is ideal for starting new projects, setting intentions, and taking the first steps toward manifesting the desires you've set for the lunar cycle ahead.



First Quarter

_The First Quarter moon marks the midway point between the New Moon and Full Moon. It's a great phase for rituals focused on attraction, success, and abundance, as well as for increasing positive energy. If you're working, on a long-term spell, this phase is the perfect time to infuse your intentions with a boost of energy, helping to propel your manifestations forward.

Waxing Gibbous

_The Waxing Gibbous moon is all about rapid growth and manifestation. With the Full Moon on the horizon, this is a time to nurture your intentions with patience and trust, knowing that the seeds you planted during the New Moon are beginning to grow and will soon come to fruition.

 Hold your intentions in one hand and your list of actions in the other. Close your eyes and visualize the energy of the waxing moon empowering both of them to manifest.

· Speak your commitment out loud with a few words of affirmations like 1 am fully committed to manifesting my desires. With each step I take, I am closer to my goal."



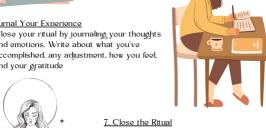


6. Complete the Ritual
