Arizona Refugee Career Pathways Program



This program with job skills training is for you!

Arizona State University (ASU), Goodwill of Central and Northern Arizona (GCNA), and the Welcome to America **Project** (WTAP) are collaborating to offer resettled refugees in the metro Phoenix area an opportunity to gain valuable job skills training, career guidance, and English language training.

If you are selected, there is no cost to participate, and direct assistance may be available in some cases.

As a participant, you will work directly with a Career Coach over the course of one year on an Individualized Career Success Plan.

There will be a job skills training, including resume building, interview techniques and soft skills to help you secure a job, advance in your current career, or make a career change.

The program will allocate a professional development fund to each participant. Funds will be available for training or certification that would be aligned with each participant's professional Career Success Plan.

You will also learn of employment opportunities through our network of partners and interact with practitioners at ASU through an interactive Speaker Series.

We offer job skills training for employment in many areas including:

- Finance and Insurance •
- Healthcare and Social Assistance •
- Administrative Support and Waste Management and Remediation Services •

Who is eligible?

We enthusiastically invite you to apply if you:

- Are a refugee resettled to the United States in the past five years.
- Live in the metro Phoenix area (ability to transport yourself to and from classes and meetings is required).
- Have adequate English skills (an English proficiency test will be administered if you are invited to the • interview round).
- Can commit to attending all required AZRCP events for one year, both in-person and virtual.
