Required California Notary Journal Data

Intended as a Study Aid

Data that needs to be written in your Notary Journal:

- 1. Date of notarization
- 2. Time that document was signed
- 3. Type of notarial wording/legal language used
- 4. Address where notarization took place
- 5. Title of document being signed
- 6. Date of document, defaults to notarization date if none
- 7. Name of signer based on their ID
- 8. ID number
- 9. Expiration date of ID
- 10. Issuance date of ID
- 11. Amount charged for notarization
- 12. Signature of person being notarized
- 13. Thumbprint of signer, if required

Pre-Printed Notary Journals may not be specific for data required for California, be very careful that you gather the required data even if you have to rename/or ignore column headings in YOUR Notary Journal.
