What is a CSA?

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) programs provide members with the opportunity to purchase fresh, local produce by providing the means to develop direct relationships with local farmers. CSAs are mutually beneficial for both parties; by paying in advance of the growing season, members support farmers by providing much-needed funds to cover the up-front costs associated with growing food. Members benefit by receiving a weekly box of the freshest crops possible. Produce is harvested by our farmers at its peak, resulting in a diverse range of food unparalleled in freshness and nutritional value. Numerous members enjoy the surprise of new foods, since it is common to receive fruits and vegetables one may never have consumed or even heard of, so joining a CSA requires some sense of adventure and creativity!

Why join Harvest Moon's CSA?

By becoming a member of the Harvest Moon CSA, you are choosing healthy, high-quality food. As a member, you will not only receive a weekly box of fresh, local produce but you will also be directly supporting the efforts of our farm and other local farms. Here at Harvest Moon, we grow nearly 20 different crops and each week our farmers walk our fields to hand-select *the best* of what is ready to put in your box. Our crops are harvested the same day or only one day before pick up, which guarantees you receive the freshest possible produce. Our CSA manager also works closely with local farms to select fresh produce from their fields to supplement our offerings.

What is in a Harvest Moon CSA box?

As a Harvest Moon CSA member, you will reap the benefits of a wide variety of fresh produce once a week, beginning in July. The produce that comprises your CSA box will vary each week depending on what is growing and ready for harvest, so please be aware that you will receive certain crops more frequently than others. Members will receive a weekly email containing a list of what will be the probable contents of your share. Occasionally we will also include recipes for you to try at home.

Seasonal, Diverse, and Local Produce

Examples of fruits and vegetables to expect by month (for reference: a half share box contains, on average, seven items). We may occasionally include a carton of our pasture-raised eggs or our fresh-pressed cider in your share, based on availability.

Bread Share

This family-owned bakery has been the go-to destination for pastry aficionados and bread lovers alike for nearly two delicious decades. As a CSA member, you will have the option to choose from their classic plain sourdough or a weekly rotation of different sourdough varieties (i.e., asiago, olive, rosemary, walnut raisin, jalapeno cheddar, etc.). Each week, members will receive one loaf of their selected bread.

Cider & Beer Share

NEW! We are proud to announce our first-ever CSA collaboration with our on-site cidery, *Hardscrabble Cider*! All stages of the hard cider process take place right here on our Farm – from growing, picking, and cleaning apples, to pressing, fermenting, and bottling the final product. The craft beer varieties in this share are sourced from a number of excellent, small-batch breweries located throughout Hudson Valley and New York state. Cider and beer flavors will rotate weekly with both new offerings and returning favorites. Each week, members will receive a four-pack, split between hard cider and beer.

Coffee Share

NEW! We simply love *Irving Farm* coffee – they provide the very same beans that make up each cup of delicious coffee and espresso served in our own Farm Cafe! We have decided to share our passion for them with you by offering two staple blends of their award-winning coffees: 71 House, their medium house blend and Gotham, their stand-out dark roast. Located in Millerton, NY, they source all their coffee from small producers and hand-select freshly harvested lots. Each week, members will receive one 300g bag of whole bean coffee.

Milk Share

NEW! We are excited to announce that we are now offering *Battenkill Valley Creamery* premium quality dairy products! This multigenerational family-owned farm has been operating out of upstate Salem, NY for more than a century. *Battenkill* guarantees that their dairy products are the freshest possible, with all their milk going from "cow to bottle" in less than eight hours in their own facilities on their farm. *Battenkill* is the first-ever recipient of Cornell University's "Highest Quality Milk in New York State" award. CSA members can choose from a variety of milk products bottled in either glass or plastic containers.

Mushroom Share

NEW! Fresh on the scene, we're thrilled to introduce the highest-quality fungi in the region, grown locally right here in the Hudson Valley by *Westchester Mushroom Co*. This mushroom share will feature a rotating selection of gourmet mushrooms including oyster, lion's mane, chestnut, and pioppino. These varieties will bring their own distinct flavor and texture to your kitchen. Founded in Peekskill, NY in 2021, *Westchester Mushroom Co*. operates a very carefully monitored facility, ensuring that the mushrooms you receive are harvested just hours before delivery! Each week, members will receive one 8 oz bag of mushrooms.

Beef Share

We raise our own prize herd of Red Devon cattle on our 1,200-acre sister farm located sixty miles upstate in Hillsdale, NY. This hearty, ancient breed of cattle are remarkably resilient and great at grass-based production which leads to high-quality, great-tasting beef. Our 100% grass-fed, antibiotic-free, and hormone-free cattle are raised entirely outdoors and roam freely over hundreds of acres of wide-open pasture. Each week, members will receive a one-pound package of ground beef.

Cheese Share

The Harvest Moon add-on cheese share features cheeses that hail from all over New York's Hudson Valley. Members will be able to sample a delicious assortment of textures and flavors, all crafted from cow, goat, or sheep's milk. Members will receive one package of cheese each week.

Flower Share

We are pleased to offer a truly local farm share from *Wild Iris Flower Farm*, a local boutique flower farm based right here in North Salem, NY. Growers of specialty heirloom and seasonal cut flowers, this special add-on includes a weekly, gorgeous bouquet hand-crafted with an assortment of seasonal, locally grown, and hard to find flower varieties.
