Front Wheel / Rear Wheel Class Rules

DISCLAIMER TO CAR BUILDERS AND DRIVERS: IF IT DOES NOT SAY YOU CAN DO IT WITHIN THESE RULES, DO NOT DO IT. ALL CARS FOUND TO BE ILLEGAL WILL NEED TO BE CORRECT TO PASS OFFICIALS INSPECTION, CARS THAT DO NOT PASS INSPECTION WILL NOT RUN.

- 1. If the vehicle does not pass inspection, there will be NO refund.
- 2. All rules must be followed, or you will not run.
- 3. Any driver caught drinking during the event will be asked to leave.
- 4. All drivers must be 16 years of age.
- 5. All official judges' decisions will be final.
- 6. Drivers must wear seat belt, helmet, and eye protection.
- 7. Drivers must wear long sleeved shirt, long pants, and closed-toed shoes.
- 8. No hot rodding in the pits.
- 9. No Derby built cars allowed.
- 10. Any tire with any tread. NO studded tires. Skid steer, rod weeder, or tractor type tires Will BE ALLOWED.
- 11. All vehicles must have working brakes.
- 12. Gas tanks may stay in factory locations if they are in front of the rear axle.
 - a. Otherwise, the original gas tank must be removed, and a metal or plastic six gallon maximum capacity tank must be securely fastened in front of the rear axle, inside the car. It must not leak and must be properly ventilated. (Boat tanks are highly recommended). Regular, unleaded, diesel, and aviation fuel will be the only fuels allowed to be used. No exotic fuels. All tanks must be covered with a non-absorbent cover such as a mud flap or inner tube. This is to prevent fuel splashing on the driver. (All Tanks must be made of metal or must be completely surrounded by metal. NO EXCEPTIONS)
- 13. Air bags must be removed.
- 14. Battery must be securely fastened down.
- 15. You must have two rods from the roof to the cowl to keep the hood down and two rods from the roof to the trunk to keep it from coming inside the car.
- 16. All glass, chrome moldings, plastics, antennas, and any dangerous objects must be removed.
- 17. All plastic bumper covers must be removed.
- 18. Numbers must be painted on both sides of the front doors and must include a fin on the roof with the number viewable. The numbers must be a minimum of 12".
- 19. Doors must be welded or chained.
- 20. Hood and trunk must either be welded or chained.
- 21. Hood and trunk must have 2 inspection holes no smaller than 6" in case of a fire.
- 22. Any fuel leakage will result in disqualification.
- 23. No bumper modifications.
- 24. Drivers' door reinforcement is encouraged, but not mandatory.

All contestants in the Demolition Derby are independent contractors. Box Butte County Fair or their representatives reserve the right to approve or reject any and all entries. Box Butte Fair and anyone involved in promoting or participating in the event will not be held responsible for any car, parts, or personal property before, during, or after the event. All cars not removed by midnight on the night of the show will become property of the Box Butte County Fair and the venue owners.
