Entries due Monday, August 7, 2023 from 9am – 5pm with judging to begin at entry closing. This class is open to all non-professional and professional artists from high school age and beyond and will be judged in three lots - High School Students, Adult and Professional.

Exhibitors are limited to 5 pieces, with a limit of 3 pieces in any one medium.

All exhibits must be original and completed within the last 2 years and not previously shown at this fair. All work must be framed **or** matted ready to show.

Purple and blue ribbons awarded at judge's discretion with a total of \$125.00 allotted to this division to be divided as the show warrants, maximum purple ribbon award \$2.00, maximum blue ribbons award \$1.50.

Winners must pick up premium money, ribbons, and exhibits on Sunday, August 14, 2022 from 10am-12pm, when exhibits are released.

If you are unable to pick up your exhibit during the specified time, please discuss another time with Carol Wacker.
