

## **Trinity Sunday Bible Study 2026. (Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> May)**

### **Theme UCSI: Come Holy Spirit Transform and Unite your church for Gods Mission**

#### **Sub Theme: “Living in the Fellowship of the Triune God: Connected, Changed, and Sent”**

### **Introduction:**

Trinity Sunday is celebrated on the **first Sunday after Pentecost** Sunday in the Christian liturgical calendar.

In **2026**, Trinity Sunday falls on **May 31, 2026**.

### **Bible Readings**

- **Matthew 28:16–20** – The Great Commission
- **2 Corinthians 13:14** – The Grace of the Trinity
- **John 14:15–17, 26** – Promise of the Holy Spirit
- **Genesis 1:26–27** – “Let us make humankind...”

## **Understanding the Trinity**

The Trinity means:

- **God the Father** – Creator
- **God the Son (Jesus Christ)** – Savior
- **God the Holy Spirit** – Sustainer and Guide

One God, three persons, working together in perfect unity and love.

### **Discussion Questions:**

- What does it mean that God exists in relationship (Father, Son, Spirit)?
- How does this shape our understanding of community in UCSI?

## **Connected in the Trinity (Fellowship)**

*2 Corinthians 13:14*

“The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.”

- The Trinity shows us **a community of love**.
- As the church, we are called to reflect this unity.

### **Application:**

- In UCSI, we are called to:
  - Build unity across islands, cultures, and languages
  - Care for one another as one body

### **Discussion:**

- How can we strengthen unity in our church and communities?
- What challenges divide us, and how can the Trinity guide us to overcome them?

## **Changed by the Trinity (Transformation)**

*John 14:26*

- The Holy Spirit teaches, reminds, and transforms us.
- Through Jesus, we receive salvation.
- Through the Father, we are given identity and purpose.

### **Key Point:**

The Trinity is not just a doctrine—it is **a living experience that changes us**.

### **Application:**

- Allow the Spirit to:
  - Transform attitudes
  - Heal broken relationships
  - Renew communities affected by issues like injustice or environmental harm

### **Discussion:**

- In what ways has God changed your life?
- Where do we need transformation in our communities?

## **Sent by the Trinity (Mission)**

*Matthew 28:19*

“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.”

- The Trinity is **missionary by nature**:
  - The Father sends the Son
  - The Son sends the Spirit
  - The Spirit sends the Church

### **Application:**

- UCSI is called to:
  - Share the Gospel
  - Stand for justice (against issues like exploitation, violence, and corruption)
  - Care for creation

### **Discussion:**

- Where is God sending us today?
- How can we be active in God’s mission in Solomon Islands?

## **Trinity and Creation.**

*Genesis 1:26*

- Creation itself reflects the Trinity’s cooperation.
- We are called to:
  - Respect and care for creation
  - Live responsibly in our environment

### **Discussion:**

- How does caring for creation reflect the work of the Trinity?
- What practical steps can we take as a church?

## **Closing Reflection**

The Trinity teaches us:

- **Love** (from the Father)
- **Grace** (through the Son)
- **Fellowship and Power** (by the Holy Spirit)

We are:

- **Connected** in God's love
- **Changed** by God's presence
- **Sent** for God's mission
