Set up a Business

Need to do to set up depends on your type of business, where you work and whether you take people on to help.

- Sole Traders it's simpler to set up as a sole trader, but you're personally responsible for your business's debts. You also have accounting responsibilities.
- Limited Companies if you form a limited company, its finances are separate from your personal finances, but there are more reporting and management responsibilities.
- Partnerships a partnership is the simple way for 2 or more people to run a business together. You share responsibility for your business's debts. You also have accounting responsibilities. Find out more about being a partnership and how to register.
