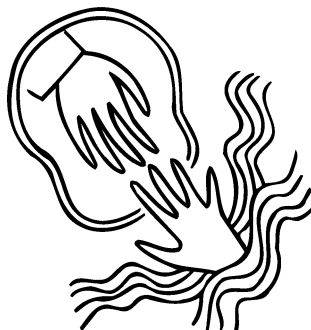
Psalm 18
