


## 5<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

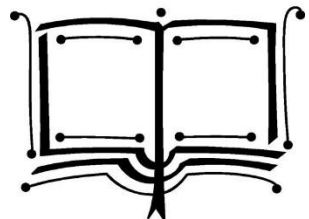
