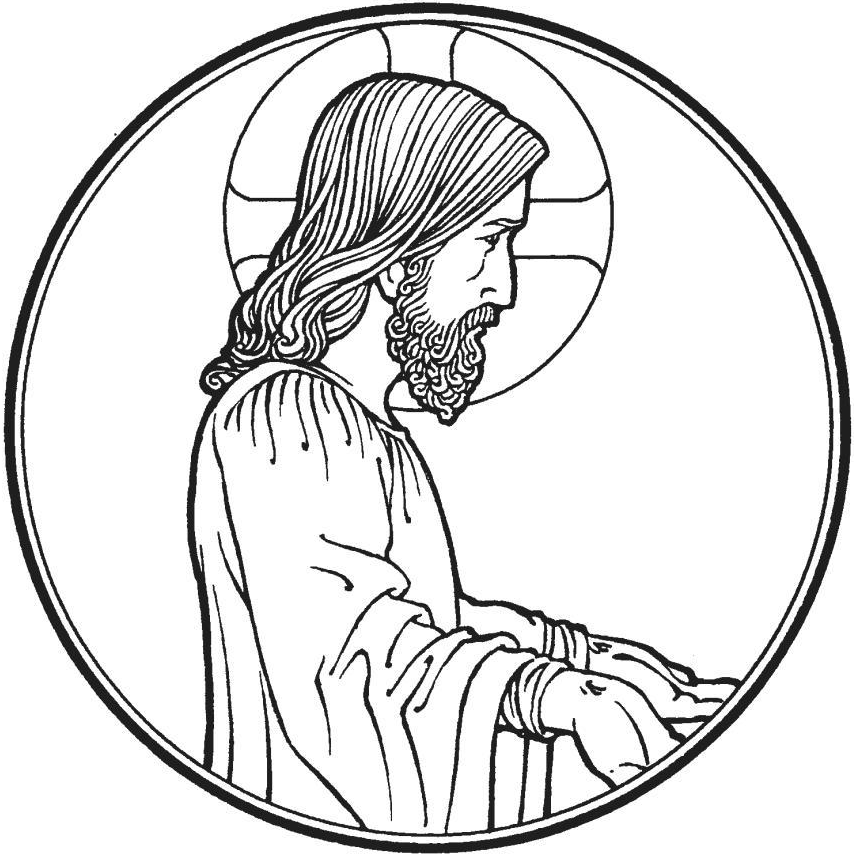


# GRACE AT HOME
